THE PUSSYCAT DOLLS PRESENT (WORKING TITLE) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older.
- 2. Applicants must be available on a full-time, exclusive basis from June 2007 through August 2007, as may be changed by AFN Productions, Inc. (hereafter "Producers") in their sole discretion. The exact date and location of the finals may be changed at any time by Producers in their sole discretion. Economy travel and hotel accommodations (room and tax only excluding all incidental or other charges) will be arranged and paid for by Producers. Your schedule will be entirely at the sole discretion of the Producers.
- 3. Applicants must not be candidates for public office at the time of application, and if an Applicant is selected as a participant in the program, that Applicant must agree not to become a candidate for public office until after the initial broadcast of all programs in which that Applicant may appear.
